



Conventional natural gas consumption (26,941 GWh1 reached its maximum for a month of March since available data (2004)

Preliminary Consumption Information March 2018

In March, road fuel consumption rose (+0.2% respect to March 2017), gasolines (+2.5%) ascended whilst road diesel diminished (-0.3%). Road fuel consumption increased by 3.1% in the first guarter of the year regarding 1Q2017, having been greater the increment in gasolines (+3.8%) than in road diesel (+2.9%).

This month, consumption of every petroleum product group ascended: LPG (+20.8%), gasolines (+2.5%), kerosene (+9.0%), road diesel (+1.0%) and fuel oil (+8.8%). In the year to date, each petroleum product group presented interannual growth except for LPG (-6.2%): gasolines (+3.8%), kerosene (+6.8%), gasoil (+3.4%) and fuel oil (+6.7%).


Once again, natural gas consumption rose in March (+7.5% respect to March 2017), having placed itself in 31,465 GWh. Conventional natural gas consumption outstood (+8.2%), having reached 26,941 GWh, maximum for a month of March since available data (2004). Direct consumption LNG (+24.4%) also increased, whilst the one intended for electricity generation (-2.2%) decreased. Consumption in the first quarter of the year augmented 4.1% respect to 1Q2017, having been the greatest consumption for a first quarter since 2012.


Road fuels consumption 2011-2018
