



Preliminary Consumption Information March 2019


In March, road fuel consumption decreased (-2,3% vs. March 2018)

In March, the first interannual decline of road fuel consumption was produced since September 2018, -2,3% vs. March 2018, due to the decrease of gasoil (-3.3%), offset by the increase of gasoline (+2.7%). Road fuel consumption increased slightly in the first quarter of the year (+0.1% vs. Q12018), gasoline increased (+5.2%) whilst road diesel decreased (-0.9%).


This month, gasolines consumption (+2.7%), kerosene (+6.4%) and fuel oil (+3.1%) rose, whilst LPG (-18.1%) and gasoil (-6.1%) consumption decreased. In the year to date, every petroleum product group presented interannual growth, except gasoil (-1.3%): LPG (+2.3%), gasolines (+5.2%), kerosene (+4.9%), and fuel oil (+4.7%).

For the second consecutive month, natural gas consumption diminished (-0.9% vs. March 2018), to 31,135 GWh. Consumption intended for electricity generation, as in the first two months of the year, presented a significant increase (+45.2%). Furthermore, direct consumption LNG also increased (+8.6%), whilst conventional consumption decreased by 6.8%. First quarter consumption rose by 4.7% vs. Q12018, the one intended for electricity generation (+33.3%) and direct consumption LNG (+13.5%) rose, whilst conventional consumption presented no variation.
