



Preliminary Consumption Information

March 2020

In March, road fuel consumption decreased [-25.2% vs. March 2019]


After the statement declaring the State of Alarm 14th March, this month there was a significant decrease of road fuel consumption by -25.2% vs. March 2019, having reached 1,769 kt, the lowest consumption since January 1999. Gasolines presented the highest decrease (-34.4% vs. March 2019; 276 kt) with the lowest consumption since February 1973, whilst road diesel with 1,493 kt fell by -23.2% vs. March 2019, the lowest consumption since February 2002. Road fuel consumption in Q1 2020 fell by -7.5% vs. Q1 2019, both gasolines (-7.0%) as well as road diesel (-7.6%) decreased.

This month every petroleum product groups decreased, except for LPG (+18.3%): kerosene presented the greatest decline (-43.6%), followed by fuel oil (-36.6%), gasolines (-34.5%) and gasoil (-8.3%). In the Q1 2020, every petroleum product groups presented interannual decreases: LPG (-0.2%), gasolines (-7.0%), kerosene (-14.9%), gasoil (-0.3%) and fuel oil (-34.3%).

In March, natural gas consumption decreased (-6.9% vs. March 2019), having reached 29,060 GWh. Conventional consumption experienced a lower decrease (-4.2%) than the one intended for electricity generation (-23.4%), whilst direct consumption LNG rose by 9.0%. Consumption in the first quarter of the year diminished by 3.7% vs. Q1 2019.
