May 2018 Road gasolines consumption in May

Once again, in May, road fuel consumption increased (+2.0% vs. May 2017). Both road diesel (+1.3%) and gasolines (+5.0%) rose, continuing with their recovery path, surpassing for the first time the consumption level of May 2011. In the year-to-date, road fuel consumption increased by 3.1%, being higher the

increment in gasolines (+3.5%) than in road diesel (+3.0%).

Information

This month, consumption of gasolines (+5.0%), kerosene (+4.7%) and road diesel (+1.9%) increased, whilst LPG (-0.9%) and fuel oil (-3.3%) descended. Likewise, in the year-to-date, every petroleum product group presented year-on-year growth, except for the LPG (-1.7%): gasolines (+3.5%), kerosene (+5.5%), gasoil (+4.0%) and fuel oil (+6.7%).


In May, for the fourth consecutive month, natural gas consumption rose (+10.1% vs. May 2017). The consumption intended for electricity generation presented a remarkable increment (+23.2%), likewise conventional and direct consumption LNG increased (+6.4% and +36.4%, respectively). In the year-to-date, natural gas consumption rose by +6.0% because of the increments of all consumption types: conventional (+6.6%), electricity generation (+2.1%) and direct consumption LNG (+6.0%).


Road fuels consumption 2011-2018
