

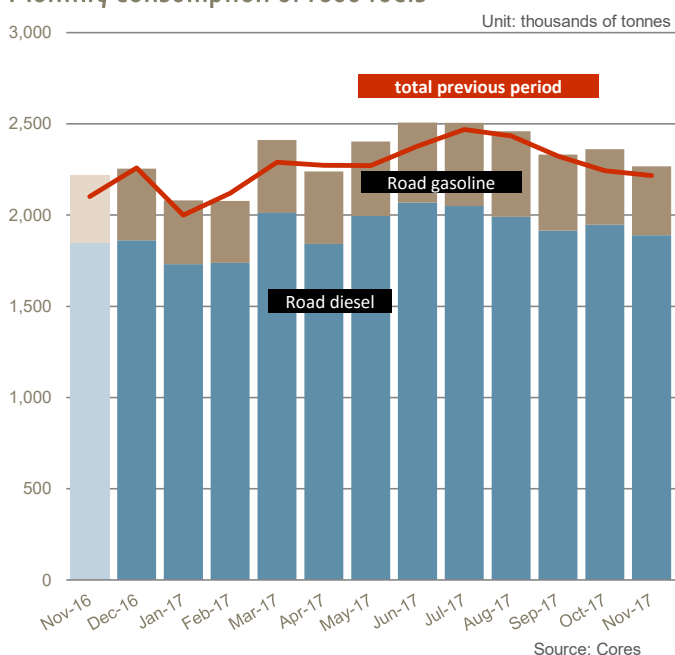
Conventional natural gas consumption (25,407 GWh) reached the maximum for a month of November since available data (2004)

In November, for the seventh consecutive month, road fuel consumption rose (+2.3% regarding November of 2016), having surpassed the November consumption of the 6 preceding years. Both road diesel (+2.2%) and gasolines (+2.8%) increased. In the year to date road fuel consumption augmented 2.5%.

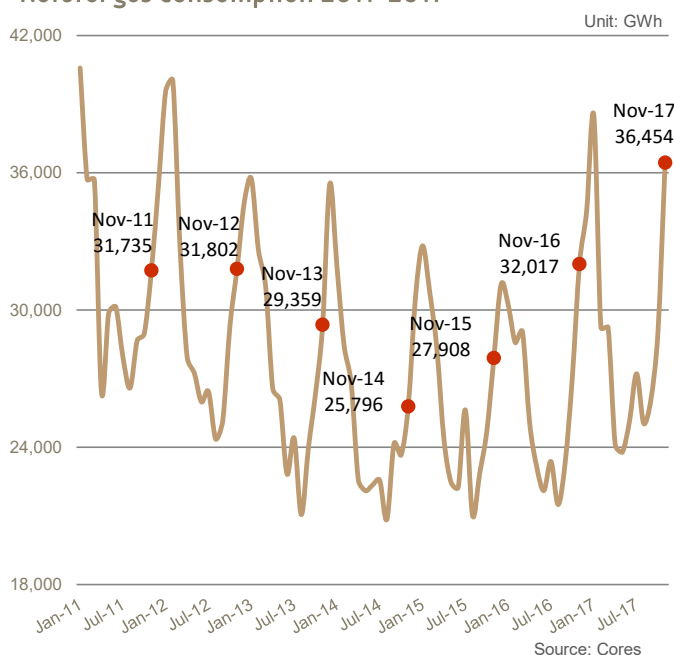
In November, the consumption of every petroleum product group increased, except for fuel oil (-2.6%) and LPG's (-41.5%): gasolines (+2.8%), kerosene (+6.7%) and gasoil (+2.6%). In the year to date gasolines (+2.4%), kerosene (+8.9%) and gasoil (+1.7%) registered positive variation rates, whilst LPG's and fuel oil diminished 7.9% and 3.9% respectively.

The greatest data for a month of November were registered for natural gas consumption since 2010, having risen 13.9% in comparison with November 2016; conventional consumption outstood (+8.0%), having reached 25,407 GWh, maximum since available data (2004). The consumption intended for electricity generation and direct consumption LNG also increased with respect to November 2016 (+31.8% and +17.1% respectively). In the year to date, natural gas consumption ascended 9.9%, because of the increments in every consumption type: conventional (+5.0%), electricity generation (+31.8%) and direct consumption LNG (+5.6%).
