

Natural gas imports by country

April 2014

Decrease in April of pipeline imports (-14.9%), whilst LNG increased by +29.1%

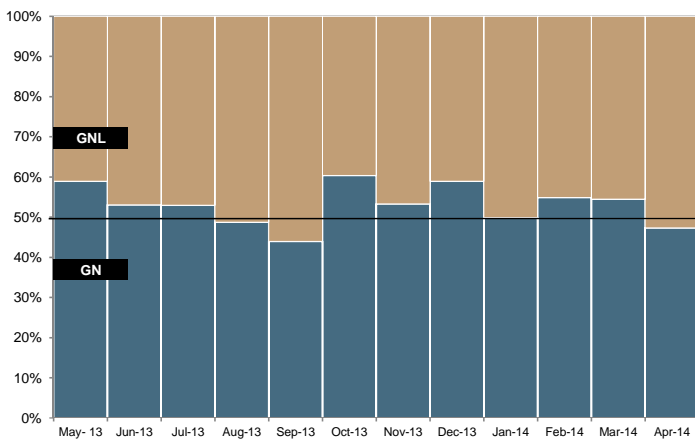
Natural gas imports in Spain in April 2014 came to 33,032 GWh, with a year-on-year increase of 3.8%. For the rolling year they reached 382,685 GWh, decreasing by 0.2% with regard to the previous rolling year.

Increased imports from all countries with a exception of Peru (-21.8%) and Trinidad & Tobago (-50.4%). Increased exports, which account for 27.4% in April over imports.

Algeria was the leading supplier, with 59.5% of the total, reaching 56.6% year to date (**). Notable decrease of -17.0% NG and LNG increased 110.0% in April, compared with -2.4% and +60.0% respectively year to date.

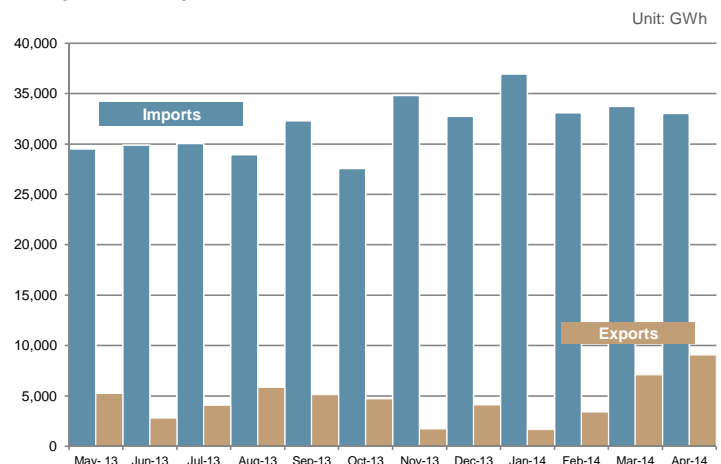
47.3% of total imports were brought in by gas pipeline, with a year-on-year reduction of 14.9%, rising by 19.4% in the rolling year. LNG imports increased by 29.1% this month whilst there is a decrease of 15.7% for the rolling year.
