



Natural gas imports & exports in Spain by country

February 2015

Spain's natural gas net imports in February reach 26,268 GWh, presenting an 11.6% interannual decrease due to the drop in natural gas net imports brought in by gas pipeline (-24.5% vs. February 2014). However, LNG net imports increase this month by 7.5%.

As for natural gas imports, they decrease for the fourth consecutive month (-16.2% compared to February 2014) to 27,758 GWh, minimum value registered since October 2013. Spain's main gas suppliers for the month are Algeria (48.5%), Norway (14.0%), Qatar (12.8%) and Nigeria (7.3%).


The year-on-year decrease of 56.2% registered by natural gas exports (1.491 GWh) is remarkable. Not taking into consideration exports to Portugal, which increase mainly due to the disappearance of the concept of *transit*, barely any gas has been exported in February, in contrast to the tendency of the past twelve months, where exports have increased 50.3%.

In the rolling year, LNG exports represent 85.2% of total exports, whereas those transported through pipeline make up the 14.8% remaining.



Import weight by type of supply



Import distribution January - February 2015**




Export distribution January - February 2015
