

# Natural gas imports & exports in Spain by country



#### March 2016

After last February's fall, net imports of natural gas are 27,262 GWh in March, experiencing a growth of 12.0% and a rise of 21.7% compared to February 2016. Both LNG net imports (+18.0%) and natural gas by pipeline (+4.8%) increase.


Natural gas imports to Spain reache 29,841 GWh this month, 14.3% higher than March 2015, month in which the minimum value of 2015 natural gas imports was recorded. Compared to February 2016, imports increase by 20.4%. Geographically, this month there is a rise in imports from Africa (+32.5%) and Europe and Eurasia (+12.4%), whilst Central and South America (-34.5%) and Middle East (-24.6%) decrease.

The main suppliers of natural gas to Spain in the YTD are Algeria (54.5%), Norway (13.0%), Nigeria (13.0%) and Qatar (10.0%).


This month, exports of natural gas reach 2,580 GWh, 46.2% above March 2015, when the second annual minimum value after February 2015 was recorded. This month, only 2.0% of exports are made in liquid state to France, Italy, Portugal and Switzerland. The remaining 98% is exported via pipeline to both Portugal and France (97.7% and 0.3% respectively of total exports).

### Natural gas net imports increase (+12.0% vs. March 2015)


#### Import weight by type of supply




#### Import distribution by geographical areas
