





May 2016

Net imports of natural gas increased by 7.3% compared to May 2015, reaching 24,297 GWh, but are down in the current year for the second consecutive month. Rise in both LNG and NG net imports (53.4% of total): 9.6% and 5.4%, respectively.


Increase in natural gas net imports (+7.3% vs. May 2015) In May, Spain imported 27,907 GWh of natural gas, 8.1% less than in May 2015. It is noticeable the decline in imports from Central and South America and Europe and Euroasia (-64.4% and -42.5%, respectively), compared with an annual increase of imports from the Middle East (+ 3.3%) and Africa (+ 3.0%). Africa registered a steady increase since March 2016 (+35.8% vs. February 2016, annual minimum).

Exports this month fell by 53.3% compared to May 2015, reaching 3,610 GWh. However, compared to previous months, a positive rate of change for the third consecutive month was recorded (+51.0% vs. February 2016). Since February 2016, Spain has only exported natural gas to Europe and Eurasia.

In the YTD, it has been exported a 24.0% less than in 2015, to 15,485 GWh, 92.0% by pipeline and the remaining 8.0% as LNG.

Import weight by type of supply


Import distribution by geographical areas
