# Natural gas imports & exports in Spain by country

#### November 2016

This month, net imports of natural gas stand at 29,740 GWh (-1.1% compared to November 2015), accumulating an increase of 41.6% in the last four months. Net LNG imports rise (+3.4%) while GN imports fall (-4.8%).


This month, Natural gas inflows to Spain reach 33,378 GWh, down 3.4% from November 2015, when the maximum level for the year was recorded.

By geographical area, supplies from the Middle East (-58.8%) and Africa (-5.4%) decrease, the latter due to lower imports from both Algeria and Nigeria (-6.1% and -1.3%, respectively). On the other hand, imports from Central and South America (+114.2%) and Europe and Europeia (+23.1%) continue to increase.


In the year-to-date, the main suppliers of natural gas to Spain are Algeria (57.7%), Nigeria (14.4%) and Norway (10.6%).

Exports experienced a year-on-year decline (-18.6%) to 3,638 GWh. This month, exports by pipeline (98.0% of the total) increase (+ 27.9%) while LNG (-95.7%) decrease. For the fourth consecutive month, Spain only supplies Europe and Euroasia. In the year-to-date, exports fall by 21.2% to 41,661 GW, with 95.4% by pipeline and the remaining 4.6% as LNG.

#### Import weight by type of supply




Import distribution by geographical areas January-November 2016




