

Crude oil Spanish imports by country

April 2014

Again in April, decrease of OPEC imports -22.0%

In April, drop back of crude oil imports in Spain (-5.7% vs. April 2013), reaching 4,811 kt. Imports from the Middle East presented a decrease of 52.6% and 16.3% in Africa compared to April 2013, highlighting the decline of Algeria (-63.4%). Angola (192.2%), Nigeria (34.9%) and Mexico (29.2%) are the only countries showing an import increase. In April, 25 crudes from 12 countries were imported.

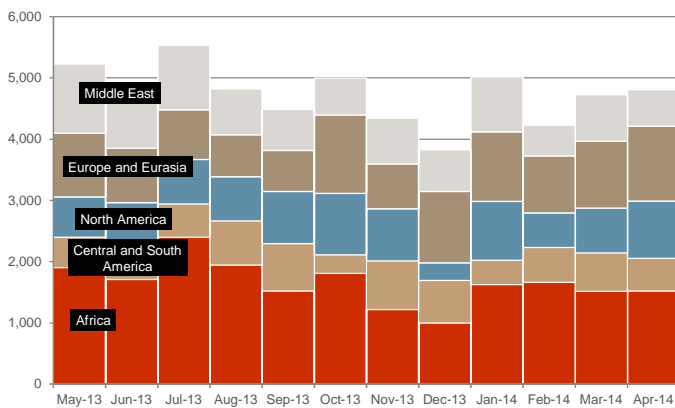
In the YTD, the main suppliers remain Russia (18.1%), Nigeria (17.3%) and Mexico (17.0%).

This month, crude oil imports from OPEC countries continue to decline (-22.0%), representing 44.8% of the total. However, in the rolling year, imports of OPEC (50.3%) remain slightly above imports from countries outside OPEC (49.7%).

Geographically, Africa remains the main area of crude oil supply in the rolling year (34.9%), despite its weight loss in the structure, in benefit areas of North America and Europe and Eurasia (16.3% and 20.5% respectively).

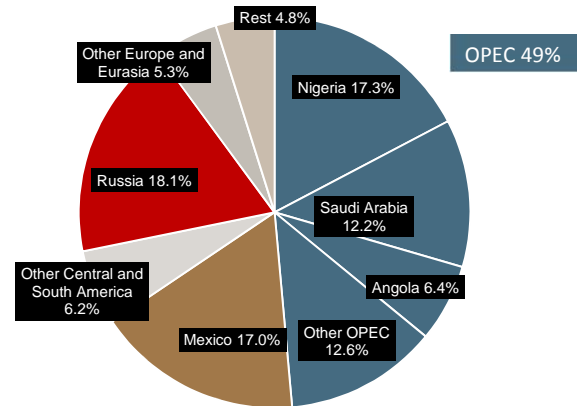
Crude oil imports by geographical area
