

Spanish crude oil imports by country

April 2015

Imports continue to increase in April +10.7% vs. April 14

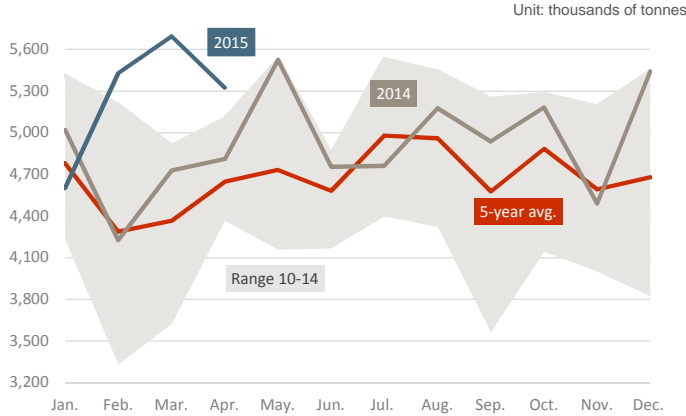
In April, crude oil imports reach 5,325 kt, 10.7% higher than those registered in April 2014, although they have decreased in relation to March 2015 (-6.5%). Imports from Central and South America rise 62.4% due to increases in imports from Venezuela (+163.5%). Also remarkable is the increase registered by Africa (+45.2%), with rises in imports from Algeria (+294.0%), Angola (+23.5%) and Gabon. However, imports from North America decrease (-35.8%), as do those from Europe and Eurasia (-34.6%), that continues to diminish its share in the structure, partly due to the continued drop registered by Russia (-32.6% vs. April 2014). Imports from OPEC countries increase 50.4% representing 60.9% of the structure in April. This month 34 types of crude oil have been imported from 17 different countries.

In the year-to-date, main suppliers are Nigeria (16.6%), Mexico (13.8%) and Saudi Arabia (11.5%).

In 2015, imports from North America slightly drop (-4.7%) and, to a larger extent, those from Europe and Eurasia (-18.2%). In contrast, imports from all other geographic areas rise, where increases from Brazil (+449.5%), Libya (+126.6%), Angola (+86.9%) and Irak (+80.4%) stand out.

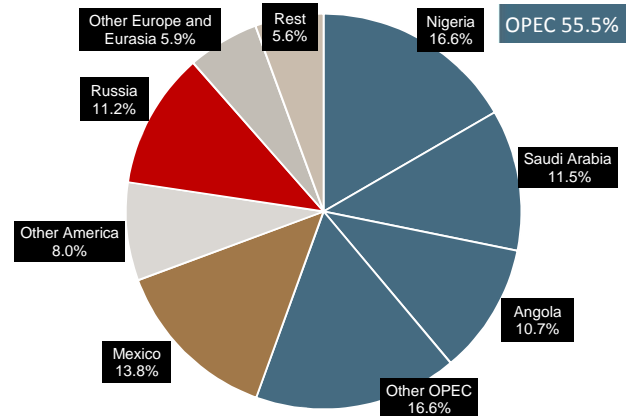
In the rolling year, Africa remains main area of crude oil supply (38.6%), followed by Europe and Eurasia (17.2%), Middle East (15.7%), Central and South America (14.4%) and North America (14.1%).
