

# Spanish crude oil imports by country

April 2017

Crude oil imports (+0.8% vs. April 2016) augmented in April up to 5,323 kt. Year-to-date (21,664 kt and +1.1% vs. Apr-16) reached the historical maximum, the same as previous month.

This month 31 types of crude oil were imported from 18 countries.

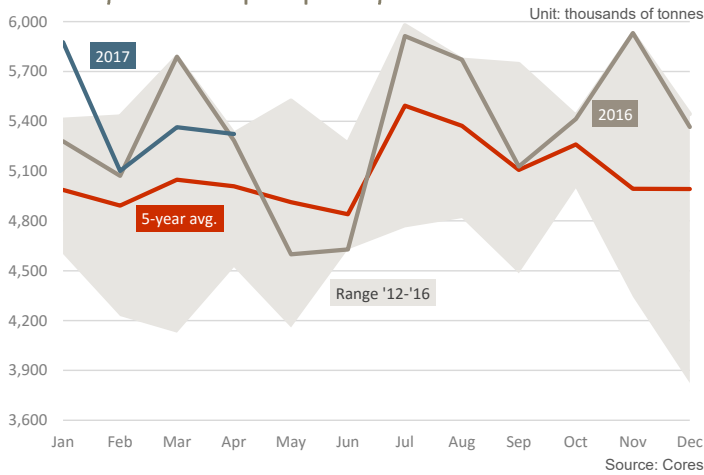
Mexico was newly positioned as the first crude oil supplier (1,026 kt), having increased 27.8% interannually, succeeded by Saudi Arabia with 682 kt (the greatest imports in 5 months). The leading source country in 2017 and rolling year is also Mexico (16.9% and 15.6% respectively), having risen 28.1% in the year and 13.7% in the last 12 months. It is followed by Nigeria (13.5%; 11.9%), Saudi Arabia (9.8%; 10.4%) and Iraq (7.3%; 8.4%).

Crude oil from OPEC countries in April reached 47.7% of the total, empowered by the increase of the supplies from Iraq (+243.8% vs. Apr-16), Saudi Arabia (+63.5%) and Algeria (+220.0%). It is counteracted by the decreases from Angola (-76.0%) and Iran (-34.9%).

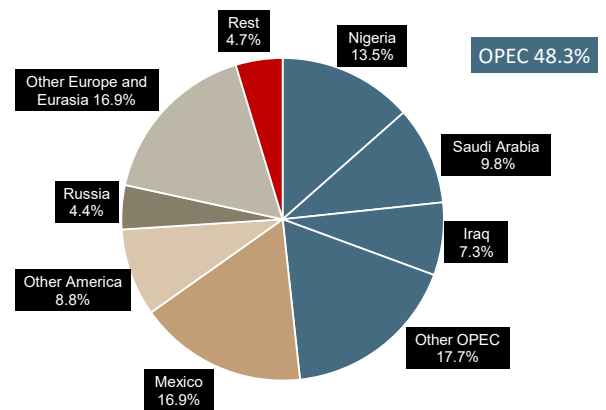
By geographical areas, this month Middle East (27.3%) is the main supplying area. In the year-to-date, Africa is the principal provider (28.3%), despite its interannual drop of 17.2%. It is seconded by Middle East (22.3% and +20.3%); Europe & Eurasia (21.3% and +1.4%) and North America (18.9% and +35.7%). Finally, the oil from Central & South America (6.2%) lessened 18.4%.
