

Spanish crude oil imports by country

August 2015

Crude oil imports increase compared with August 2014 [+12.4%]

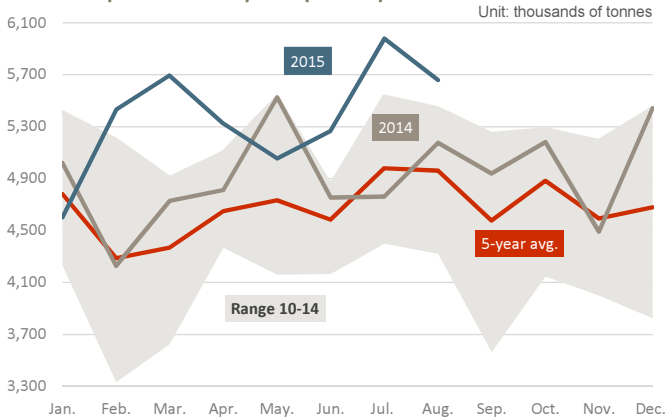
In August, crude oil imports to Spain reach up to 5,660 kt, 12.4% more than the same month of 2014. Imports from Central and South America, Middle East and Africa drop (-29.9%, -24.5% and -1.0%, respectively). These negative rates are mainly due to the decrease in imports from Venezuela (-71.6%), Saudi Arabia (-6.9%) and Nigeria (-15.1%). The previous data, together with the absence of Iraqi imports, have an effect on imports from OPEC (-8.5%), which represent 45.4% of the structure this month. On the contrary, imports from North America and Europe and Eurasia increase (+50.1% and +92.1%, respectively), where Russian imports stand out, rising 155.9% and representing a 25% share of total imports. This month, 27 types of crude oil were imported from 14 different countries.

In 2015, main suppliers are Nigeria (15.3%), Mexico (14.1%) and Russia (12.6%).

In the year-to-date as well as in the rolling year, crude oil imports from all geographic areas rise. Country-wise, increases registered in the past twelve months by Norway (+169.8%), Azerbaijan (+121.5%), Brazil (+103.0%), Iraq (+67.2%) and Angola (+22.1%) are remarkable.

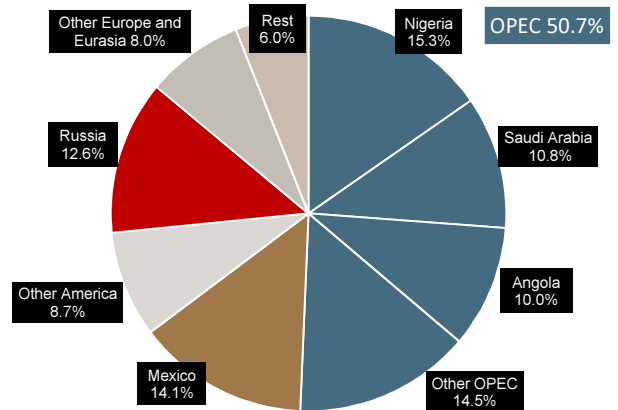
In the rolling year, Africa remains main area of crude oil supply (37.5%), followed by Europe and Eurasia (19.2%), Middle East (14.9%), North America (14.8%) and Central and South America (13.7%).
