## Spanish crude oil imports by country

## January 2017

In January 2017, crude oil imports in Spain grew an 11.3%, up to 5,876 kt, in comparison with January 2016. They emerged as the highest in a month of January since there is available information.

This month, 36 types of oil were imported from 20 different countries.


The supplies coming from Egypt (346 kt), as well as last December, became the highest since Cores´ historical data. Equally, crude oil from Canada reached an imports maximum record (216 kt; +180.5%).

Once again, the crude from the OPEC countries decreased in January. OPEC's imports share lessened to 45.1% of the total, despite the increase of the imports from Venezuela (+48.2%) and Algeria (+219.2%).


It is worth highlighting this month the rise of the inflows from North America (+111.4%); Europe & Eurasia (+36.1%) and Central & South America (+12.8%) imports also grew. However, the supplies from Middle East and Africa declined, 1.5% and 18.0% respectively.

North America and Central & South America increased their weight in the imports structure in the current month (18.7% and 13.1%, respectively) as well as in the rolling year (16.6% and 10.3% resp.).
