

Spanish crude oil imports by country

January 2020

Crude oil imports to Spain were 5,000 kt in the month of January and decreased by 15.2% interannual.

This month 33 kinds of crude oil were imported from 19 countries.

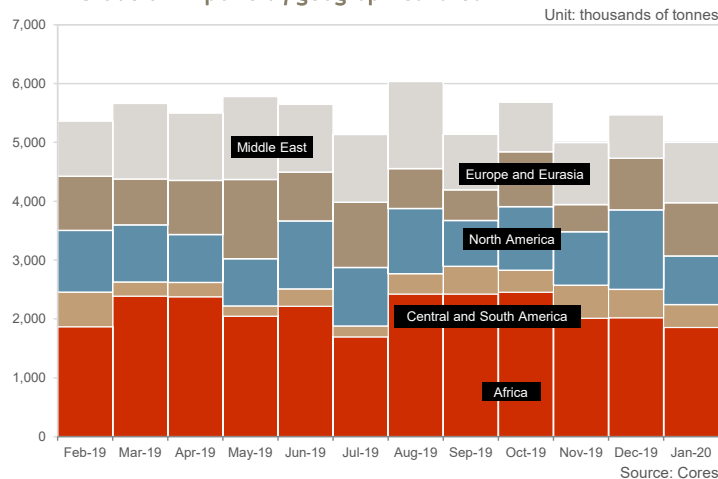
Nigeria (669 kt) became again the first crude oil supplier and slightly rose its deliveries (+1.2% vs. January 2019). Mexico (580 kt) and Saudi Arabia (517 kt) were next, both with remarkable decreases (-28.6% and -35.5% respectively). In January, crude oil imports stood out from United States (+201.2%) which reached 244 kt, and from Russia (+200.0%) which registered 300 kt.

Crude oil entries from the OPEC country members decreased (-8.9%) compared to January 2019 and meant 55.9% of the total. Libya (+2.3%) and Angola (+41.6%) rose their supplies whilst Iraq (-11.5%) diminished them.

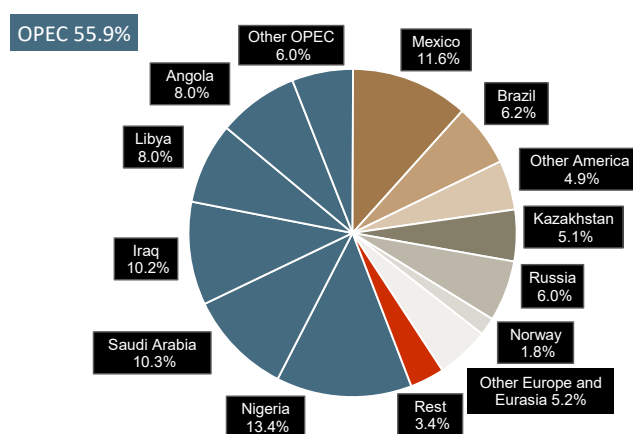
Every geographical area decreased its contributions except for Africa (+22.0% vs. January 2019), which remained as the first providing area with 37.1% of the total: Central and South America (-48.6%), Europe and Eurasia (-27.7%), Middle East (-25.5%) and North America (-16.5%).
