Crude oil imports from non-OPEC countries are 56% of the total in February In February, continues the decline in crude oil imports in Spain (-6.7% vs. February 2013), to 4,227 kt, below the average of the rolling year, 4,765 kt. The only import increases are Russia (+66.0%), Nigeria (+66.0%), Colombia (+304.2%), and Venezuela (+82.0%).

In February 23 different crudes from 14 countries were imported.



In the YTD, the main suppliers were Russia (17.2%) and Nigeria (17.1%). To highlight, the lower weight of OPEC countries, below 50% in the first two months.


In February, crude oil imports from OPEC countries continue to decline (-25.0%), representing 44.0% of the total. However, in the rolling year imports of OPEC (51.3%) remain above imports from countries outside OPEC (48.7%).

Geographically, Africa remains the main area of supply of crude oil (39.4%), despite a further decline in February (-11.3%), with Nigeria, Cameroon, Angola, Libya as main suppliers of this area.
