

Spanish crude oil imports by country

February 2018

Crude oil imports to Spain grew moderately (+0.8% vs. February 2017)

Crude oil imports to Spain slightly increased (+0.8% vs. February 2017) up to 5,140 kt. Equally, as in February 2017, maintenance works were carried out in refineries.

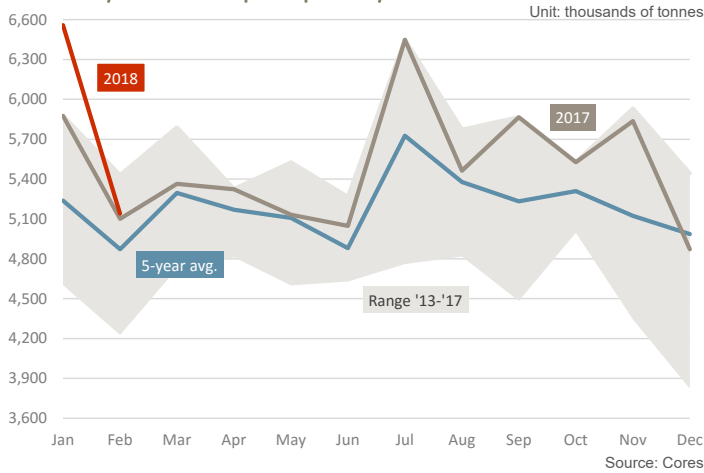
This month, 25 types of crude oil were imported from 16 different countries.

Mexico (1,023 kt) stood again as the main oil supplier to Spain, having reached 19.9% of the total, followed by Nigeria (813 kt; 15.8%), both with moderated interannual increments (+0.1% and +6.4% respectively). Libya (745 kt) was placed in third place, with a 196.8% rise regarding to February 2017. Likewise imports from Brazil (+333.7%) and Egypt (98.5%) outstood. Despite the 107.2% increment, Iran registered the fewest crude oil supplies

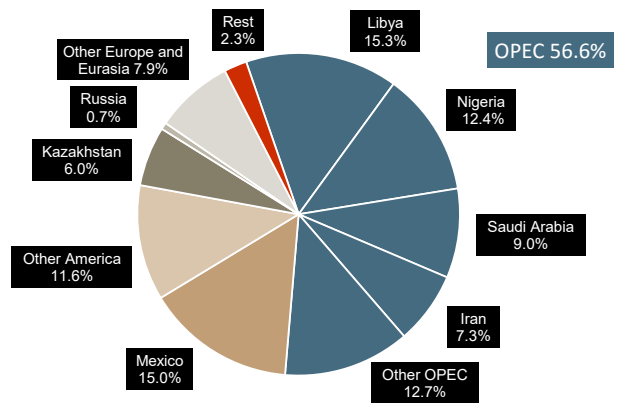
In February crude oil imports from the OPEC members (2,955 kt) rose by 16.7% interannually; empowered by crude from Saudi Arabia (+17.4%), besides the ones from Libya and Nigeria. They reached 57.5% of the total (highest share in 6 months).

All geographical areas presented positive interannual rates in the month except for Europe and Eurasia (-55.7%); Africa (+22.3%), main providing area (37.3%), Central and South America (+21.6%; 7.8% of the total), North America (+8.7%; 23.4%) and Middle East (+8.5%; 22.6%).
