



Crude oil Spanish imports by country

July 2014

In July, crude oil imports decreased (-13.9% vs. July 2013) to 4,761 kt. After two consecutive months of rises (+5.8% and +1.0% in May and June, respectively), crude oil imports resume the downward trend that began in August 2013. In July. 29 crudes from 16 countries were imported.


The Middle East registers the greatest fall (-38.3%), followed by Africa (-17.8%) and Central and South America (-9.1%). However, the escalation of imports from Angola (+323.5%) stands out, followed by an increase of imports coming from Russia (+73.5%) and Mexico (+9.4%). In July, Nigeria and Mexico are the main crude oil suppliers (18.6% and 16.6% respectively) followed by Russia (14.1%) and Angola (11.7%).

For 2014, crude oil imports from OPEC countries accumulate a drop of 9.2%, in spite of the accumulated increase for the rolling year registered by Angola, Nigeria and Venezuela (+74.1%, 22.8% and 3.7%, respectively).


Geographically, Africa remains the main area of crude oil supply in the rolling year (36.2%), followed by Europe and Eurasia (21.4%), North America and Middle East (the two latter representing 15.0% each) and, lastly, Central and South America (12.1%), despite its weight gain in the structure for the rolling year (+28.9%).
