

Crude oil Spanish imports by country

March 2014

Crude oil imports fall again in March -3.6%

Further decline in oil imports in Spain (-3.6% vs. March 2013) to 4,727 kt, on the average rolling year (4,750 kt). Imports from the Middle East show a decrease (-25%) and also those from Africa (-15.2%) compared to March 2013, despite the increase in Nigeria (47.4%). Russia (77.4%), Venezuela (32.5%), Colombia (20%) and Mexico (0.6%) also have positive increases.

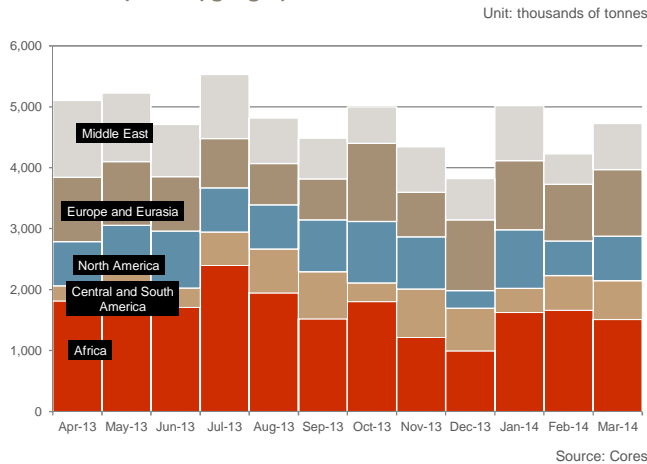
In March, 21 crudes from 13 countries were imported.

This month, crude oil imports from OPEC countries moderate their decline (-7.5%), representing 50.9% of the total. For the second consecutive month in the YTD, imports from countries outside OPEC are slightly above those from the OPEC (50.1% and 49.9% respectively).

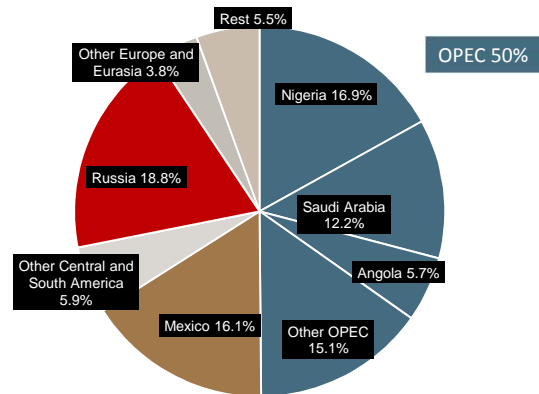
In the first quarter, the main suppliers remain Russia (18.8%), Nigeria (16.9%) and Mexico (16.1%).

Geographically, Africa accumulated in 2014 a decrease (-13.6%), exceeding the rolling year (-5.3%). Africa is the main supplier of crude oil representing 34.4% of the total, followed by Europe and Eurasia (22.6%) due to the weight of Russia (18.8%) in the total.
