

# Spanish crude oil imports by country

## May 2015

### Crude oil imports decrease -8.5% vs. May '14

In May, crude oil imports to Spain decrease (-8.5% vs. May 2014) down to 5,055 kt, although they stay an 8% above the average of the last 5 years. Only imports from North America increase (+20.8%). Most notable decreases are registered in imports from Europe and Eurasia (-15.5%) and Middle East (-24.5%), weighed down mainly by the drops of imports from Russia (-24.4%) and Saudi Arabia (-39.6%), respectively. The decrease in imports from OPEC countries is remarkable, falling 20.7% compared to those in May 2014.

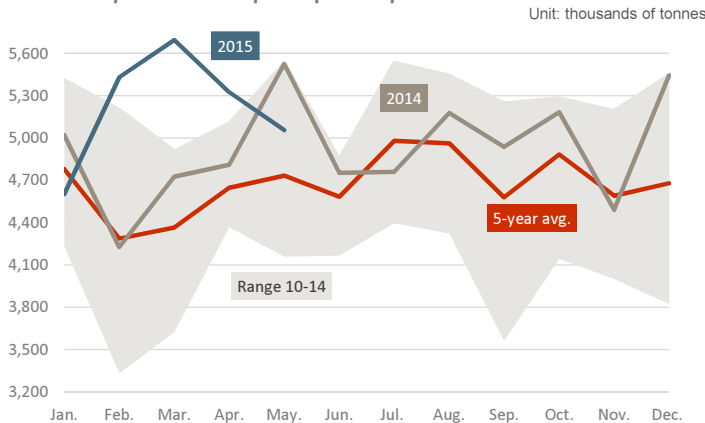
This month 31 types of crude oil have been imported from 19 different countries.

In the year-to-date, main suppliers are Nigeria (15.7%), Mexico (13.4%) and Russia (11.3%).

In 2015, imports from North America slightly drop (-0.9%) and, to a larger extent, those from Europe and Eurasia (-17.6%), maintaining the tendency of the last four months. In contrast, imports from all other geographic areas rise, where increases from Central and South America (+24.7%) and Africa (+21.9%) stand out.

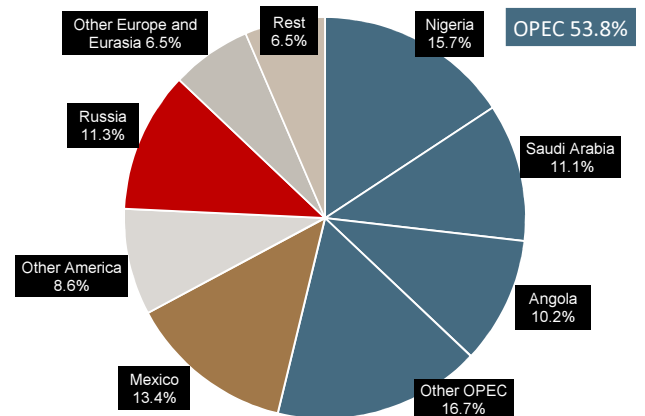
In the rolling year, Africa remains main area of crude oil supply (38.7%) and continues gaining weight in the share. Europe and Eurasia (17.0%), Middle East (15.4%), Central and South America (14.5%) and North America (14.4%) follow.
