

Crude oil imports to Spain from the OPEC members accounted for 56.6% of the total in the year to date

May 2018


Crude oil imports to Spain rose by 6.8% vs. may-17 up to 5,481 kt, the second highest figure for a month of May after 2014 (5,525 kt). Year to date and rolling year also increased, 6.4% and 4.2% respectively.


This month, 26 types of crude oil were imported from 15 countries.

Imports from Mexico (952 kt) increased by 29.7% vs. May 2017, having surpassed Nigeria (856 kt) as the main supplier. Crude oil entries from the U.S.A. (113 kt) stood out, the highest since June 2016, as well as from Russia, the greatest in 6 months. Crude oil was imported from Equatorial Guinea for the first time in 8 months.

Crude oil imports from the OPEC members rose for the sixth consecutive month (+11.3% vs. May 2017). This month, they registered significant increases from Iran (191.7%) and Saudi Arabia (+38.6%), and to a lesser extent, from Iraq (+13.0%). In the year to date, these imports rose 22.1% and reached 56.6% of the total.

Africa (27.2%) remained as the largest supplying geographical area, despite its reduction of 22.4% vs. May 2017. It is followed by Middle East, which showed an increase of 54.8% and reached 26.0% of the total. Likewise, crude oil entries rose from North America (+45.1%) and Europe and Eurasia (+2.1%), whilst having decreased from Central and South America (-12.2%).
