

Spanish crude oil imports by country

May 2019

Crude oil imports to Spain rose by 5.5% vs. May 2018 and reached 5,780 kt. Slight decreases were registered in the year to date (-1.1%), as well as in the rolling year (-0.6%).

This month 28 types of crude oil were imported from 14 countries.

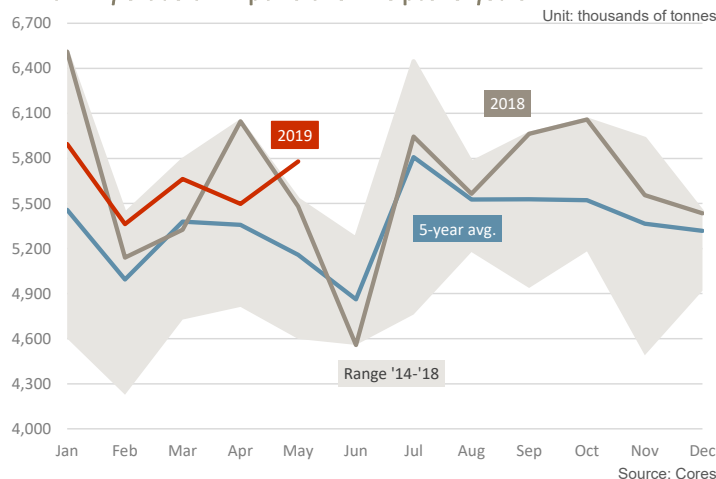
Crude oil main supplier was Nigeria (991 kt) which increased by 15.8% vs. May 2018. It was followed by Saudi Arabia (845 kt) and Libya (827 kt), both with remarkable rises, +23.9% and +146.1% respectively. Imports stood out from Russia (478 kt), the greatest since October 2016, and from Iraq (566 kt), which increased by 75.8% interannual. For the first time in 8 months no crude oil was imported from Venezuela.

Crude oil from the OPEC country members reached 54.8% of the total in the month and rose by 15.7%, whilst Non-OPEC crude oil diminished by 6.2%. Imports from the OPEC also presented rises in the rest of the periods of analysis, +2.5% in the year to date and +5.6% in the rolling year.

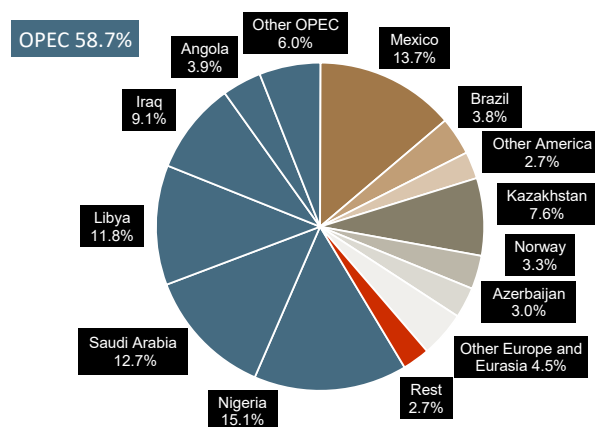
Africa (35.4%) was the main crude oil supplying area and the only region that rose its imports (+37.5% vs. May 2018), together with Europe and Eurasia (+41.0%). Contributions from the rest of the areas diminished: Central and South America (-68.4%), North America (-24.4%) and Middle East (-1.1%).
