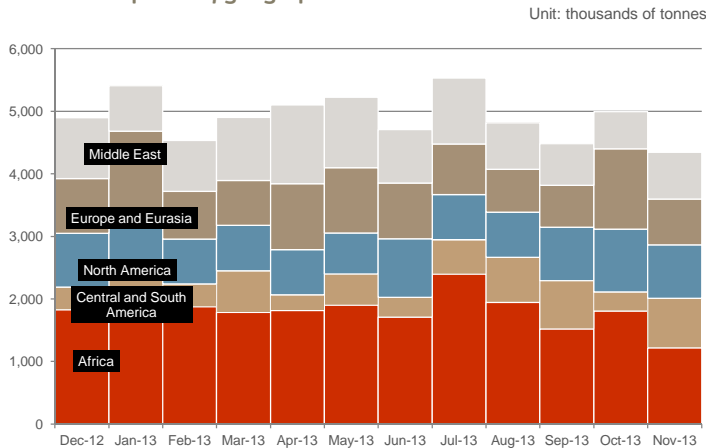
Crude oil imports in Spain dropped once again in November (-16.3% compared to November 2012), the fourth month in a row for year-on-year decreases, while in the last 12 months imports have increased by 1.3% overall. 24 types of crude oil were imported from 16 countries.

In November, Mexico was the leading supplier (16.6% of the total); in the last 12 months Mexico has continued to be the foremost supplier country for crude oil (15.9%), followed by Russia, Saudi Arabia and Nigeria. These four countries represent 56.3% of total imports in this period.

The decrease in imports from OPEC countries continued, both in the month and in the cumulative periods. In November, the absence of imports from Libya was notable, as it was only the second time this has happened in the past two years.

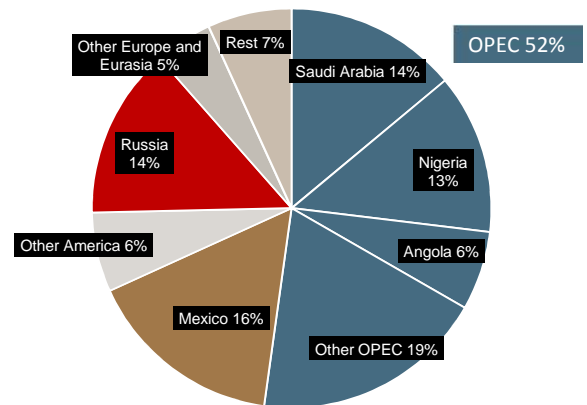
By geographical area, the imports originating in Africa decreased (-42.6% compared to November 2012). Even so, in the past 12 months Africa has continued to be the primary supply region (36.8% of the total).
