November 2014

Crude oil imports increase again in November +3.4%

In November, crude oil imports increased again (+3.4% vs. November 2013) to 4,490 kt, reaching the average value of imports registered in November for the past 5 years. Imports from the Middle East rose (+23.8%), doubling their weight in the structure in comparison with the previous month, due to the escalation of imports from Irak (+79.2%) and Saudi Arabia (+8.8%). Also notable are the increases of imports from United Kingdom (+196.3%), Angola (+94.2%) and Brazil (+60.2%). Russia (-42.8%), Nigeria (-41.6%) and Mexico (-19.4%) registered important decreases in spite of remaining main importers in the year-to-date as well as in the rolling year.


This month, 24 crudes from 16 countries were imported.

In the year-to-date, main suppliers remain Nigeria (16.8%), Mexico (14.2%) and Russia (13.4%).


This month, crude oil imports from OPEC countries increased for the fourth consecutive month (+6.9%), representing 54.6% of total imports in November.

Geographically, Africa remains the main area of crude oil supply in the rolling year (35.6%), followed by Europe and Eurasia (21.0%), Middle East (15.4%) and North America (14.1%). Lastly, Central and South America (13.9%) that maintains an upward trend, accumulating an increase of 30.6% in the past twelve months.
