

Spanish crude oil imports by country

November 2018

Crude oil imports to Spain diminished by 4.8% vs. November 2017, having placed themselves at 5,556 kt. However, they presented increments both in the year to date (+1.8%) as well as in the rolling year (+1.0%).

30 types of crude oil were imported from 16 countries.

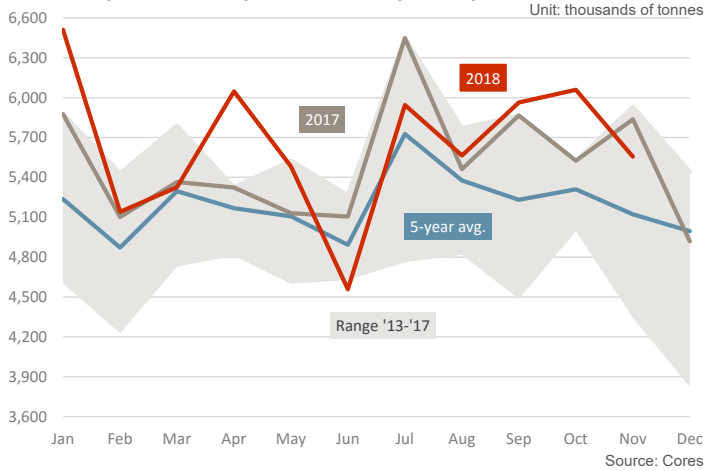
Nigeria (1,112 kt) remained as the first crude oil supplier, having increased by 66.2% interannually and having reached 20.0% of the total imports. It was followed by Mexico (876 kt), which rose by 14.1%, and registered the greatest crude oil entries in 6 months. In November, no crude oil was imported from Iran due to the USA sanctions, neither from Canada, first time in 7 months.

Crude oil entries from the OPEC country members increased by 8.9% interannually and reached 62.3% of the total, despite the absence of crude oil from Iran. Contributions from Iraq (+102.1% vs. November 2017) and Venezuela (145 kt) stood out. Crude oil from the non-OPEC countries (-21.2%) accumulated decreases for 4 consecutive months, having also descended in the year to date and the rolling year.

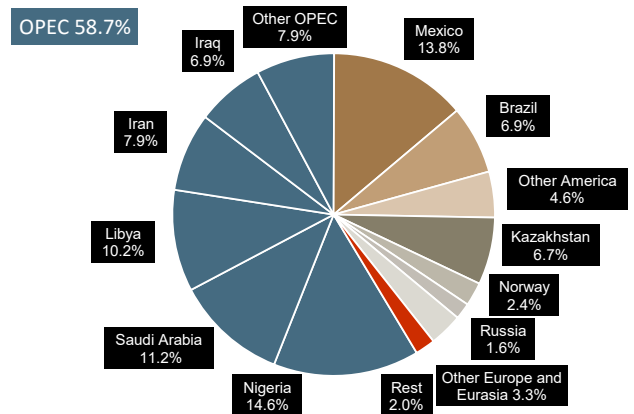
This month, every geographical area registered decreases except for Africa (+15.1%), which reached 37.8% of the total: Europe and Eurasia (-32.2%), Central and South America (-9.6%), Middle East (-8.0%) and North America (-5.7%).
