

# Spanish crude oil imports by country

## October 2015

### Nigeria top supplier for October and year-to-date

In October, crude oil imports to Spain increase again (+2.4% vs. October 2014). Rises registered by Algeria (+220.2%), Angola (+156.0%), Russia (+131.2%) and Nigeria (+23.0%) are remarkable. Imports from Nigeria represent 23.6% of the share, becoming top importer for all three analysed periods. On the other hand, imports from Central and South America, as well as those from Europe and Eurasia, drop (-30.2% and -18.2%, respectively).

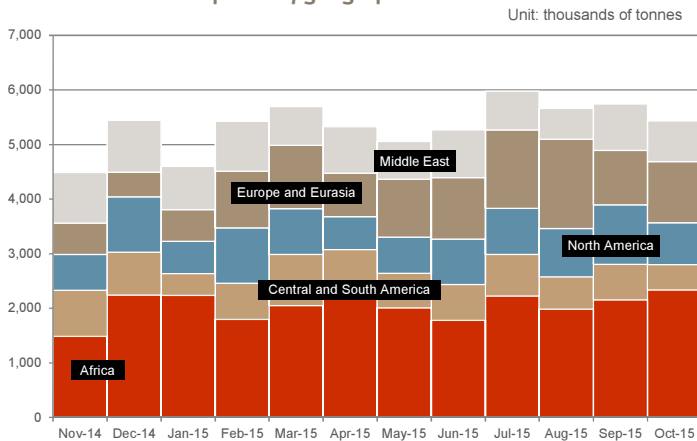
This month, 32 types of crude oil have been imported from 32 different countries.

In the year-to-date, main suppliers are Nigeria (16.4%), Mexico (14.1%) and Russia (12.6%).

This month, imports from OPEC countries rise 23.5% reaching a 59.5% of the share, whilst those from non-OPEC countries drop 18.1%.

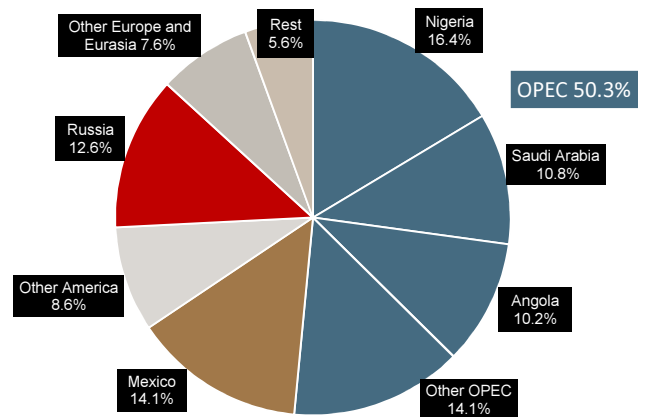
In the rolling year, Africa remains main area of crude oil supply to Spain (38.2%) and registers an increase of 21.5%. Imports from the rest of the geographical areas grow, with the exception of Europe and Eurasia (-1.9%).
