

# Spanish crude oil imports by country

## October 2016

In October, Spain imports 5,413 kt of crude oil, a slight decline compared to Oct-15 (-0.4%); the remaining two periods show the largest decreases (-2.4% in the YTD and -1.3% in year-on-year).

This month 30 types of crude oil from 20 countries have been imported.

Mexico continues to be the main supplier in the month, followed by Nigeria, which despite its decline in October returns to the top positions after five months.

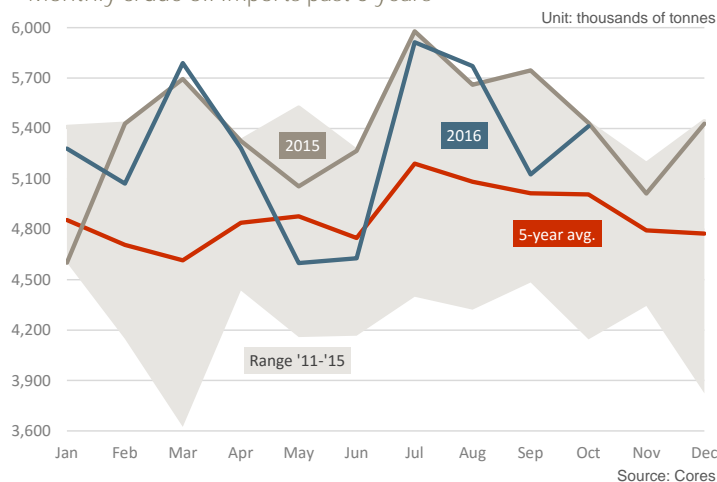
Stand out imports from Libya (352 kt), the highest of the year; those from Canada (169 kt), representing the second highest historical after Sep-15; and Colombia (445 kt), among the largest quantities supplied by this country.

Decline, for the second consecutive month, of imports from the OPEC countries (-28.8%), for the first time below 50% in the year-on-year, contributing to the decline in the share of this group in total imports from Spain.

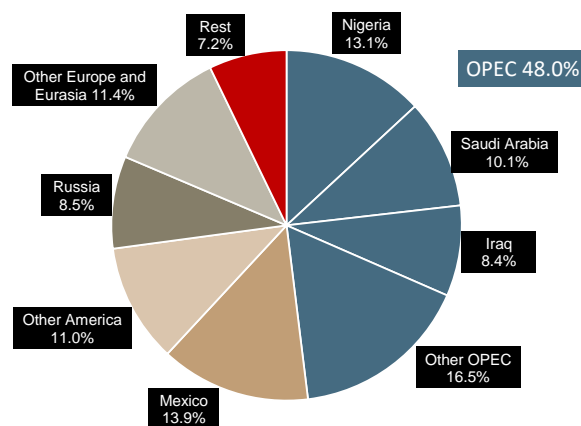
Middle East supplies grow in all three periods (+39.9%, +36.8% and +29.3%) and those from Africa (-20.4%, -19.1% and -14.0%) decrease, despite of which it remains the main supply area.
