



Crude oil imports to Spain raised in October [+2.1% vs. Oct-16]

Spanish crude oil imports by country

October 2017

Crude oil imports reached 5,526 kt (+2.1% vs. October 2016) this month, the highest value in a month of October since available data; they raised 4.3% in the year-to-date and 4.8% in the rolling year in comparison with the same period in the previous year.

In October 30 types of crude oil were imported from 17 countries.

Mexico (1,192 kt; +58,9% vs. October 2016) placed itself again as the main supplier in the month and in the year-to-date (21.6% and 15.2% of the total, respectively), having registered the highest imports since Oct-05. In the month, it is followed by Saudi Arabia (777 kt; 14.1%) and Nigeria (659 kt; 11.9%). Imports from Kazakhstan, Brazil and Iran outstood with interannual growths of 383.5%, 263.7% and 212.4% respectively.


Imports from the OPEC countries (2,876 kt) reached 52.0% of the total, having augmented in the three analysis periods: 2.9% in the month, 7.8% in the year-to-date and 4.1% in the rolling year; mainly driven by Iran and Libya and to a lesser extent, Saudi Arabia and Nigeria.

Middle East (27.1%; +26.6% vs. Oct-16) was the foremost crude oil provider to Spain for the first time in 6 months, and together with North America (25.2%; +38.4) were the only areas which presented growth. In the year-to-date, Africa remained as the main crude oil supplier, despite the diminishing in the month (-20.7%), followed by Middle East (22.3%) and Europe &Eurasia (18.4%).
