

# Crude oil Spanish imports by country

## September 2014

### Crude oil imports increase again in September +10.1%

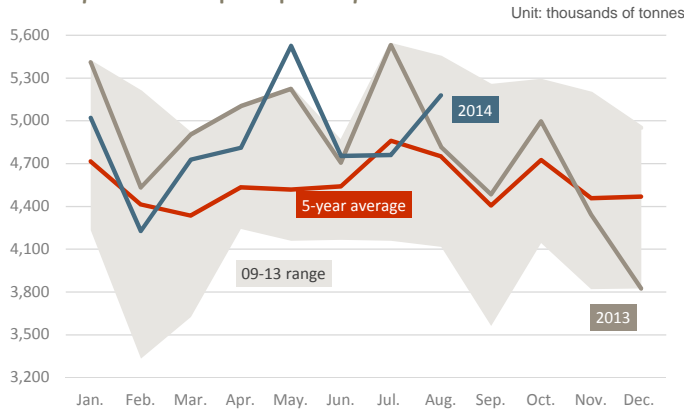
In September, crude oil imports increased again (+10.1% vs. September 2013) to 4,938 kt. Imports from all geographic areas increased, except for those coming from North America (-18.2%). The increases of imports from Nigeria (+11.8%) and Saudi Arabia (+16.5%) are notable, representing the first and third top importers in September, respectively. Imports from OECD countries increased 37.4% regarding the same period of 2013. This month, 30 crudes from 16 countries were imported.

In the year-to-date, main suppliers are Nigeria (16.7%), Mexico (14.5%) and Russia (14.3%).

For 2014, crude oil imports from OPEC countries moderate the drop registered for the year (-5.3%), due to the increases in August and September (+8.0% and +10.1%, respectively). Imports from countries outside OPEC continue to rise (+2.4% in 2014).

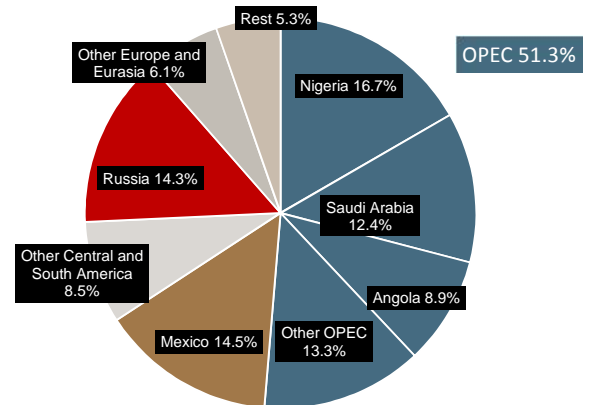
Geographically, Africa remains the main area of crude oil supply in the rolling year (35.2%), despite the decrease registered in the past twelve months (-10.5%).
