## Spanish crude oil imports by country

## September 2019

Crude oil imports to Spain decreased by 13.9% vs. September 2018 and were placed at 5,137 kt, in the year-to-date they also presented a slight descent (-0.8%). 3Q2019 registered the lowest imports for a third quarter since 2014 with a decrease of 6.7% vs. 3Q2018.


In September, 29 types of crude oil were imported from 15 countries.

Nigeria (1,251 kt) was the main crude oil supplier to Spain (+39.6% vs. September 2018), with the highest imports since October 2015. It is followed by Libya (740 kt), which rose its imports by 11.6%, and Saudi Arabia (656 kt), despite the decrease of its entries (-22.5%). This month stood out the elevated imports from Venezuela (378 kt), the greatest since November 2015, as well as the moderated contributions from Mexico (587 kt) and Iraq (285 kt), the lowest in 13 and 14 months respectively.


Crude oil imports from the OPEC country members diminished by 6.1% interannual and represented the 71.7% of the total. However, they registered rises in the year-to-date (+4.6%) and the rolling year (+8.0%), as well as in the 3Q2019 (+2.3% vs. 3Q2018).

Africa (47.2%) remained as the main supplying area, highest percentage since January 2015. The only areas which presented rises were Africa (+9.0% vs. September 2018) and Central and South America (+7.6%), having decreased Middle East (-44.6%), Europe and Eurasia (-22.9%) and North America (-16.1%).
