## 8.4% growth in year-on-year natural gas imports

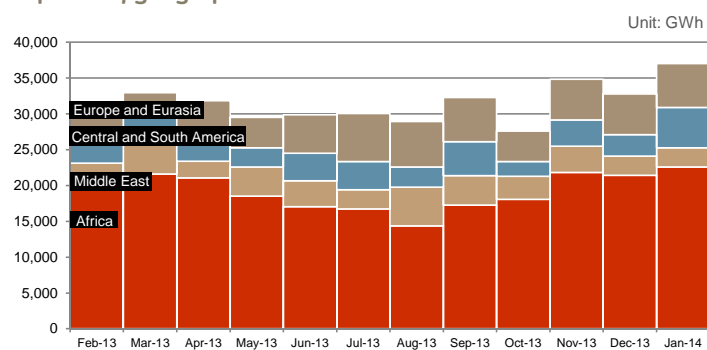
Natural gas imports in Spain in January 2014 came to 37,042 GWh, with a year-on-year increase of 8.4%. For the rolling year they reached 378,382 GWh, decreasing by 3.6% with regard to the previous rolling year.

Imports from all countries increased in January, except Nigeria (-25.0%) and Norway (-21.2%). LNG was imported from Netherlands (605 GWh) for the first time since data have been recorded (2003). There have been no LNG imports from Egypt in the last twelve months.

By geographical area, Africa continued to be the foremost gas supply region, with 61.0% in January. Algeria was the leading supplier, with 52.2% of the total.

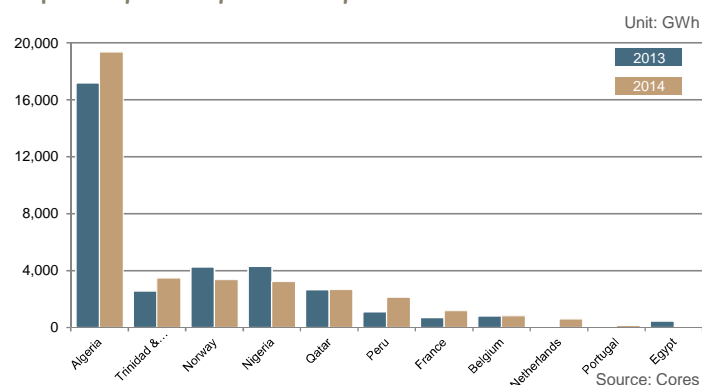
49.8% of imports were brought in by gas pipeline in January, 9.5% more than in January 2013, rising by 27.9% over the course of the rolling year.
