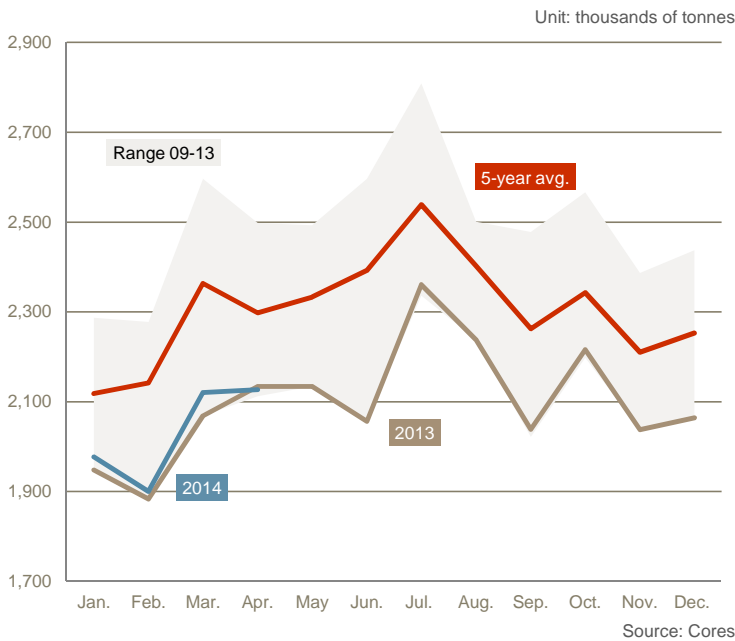
Slight decrease in road fuel consumption [-0.4% compared to April 2013]

In April, after three months of increases, there has been a slight decline in sales of road fuel (-0.4% compared to April 2013). Gasolines have a slight increase (+0.1%), while diesel road fuels decrease (-0.5%).

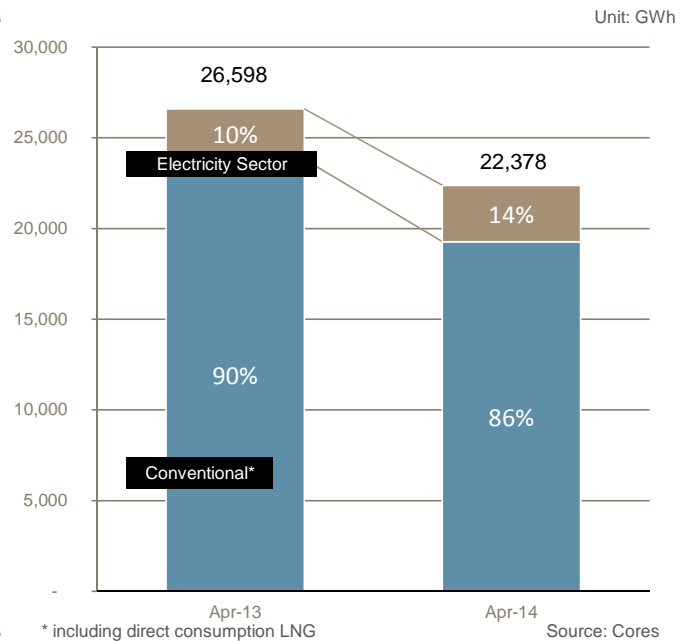
In April increases the consumption of kerosene (5.5% vs. Apr. 2013), gasoline (+0.1%) and fuel oil (+0.2%). However, there is a decline in GLPs (-8.9%) and diesel (-2.5%). YTD positives changes are recorded in gas oils (+0.1%), kerosene (+2.7%) and fuel oil (+11.5%), while gasoline and GLPs decrease 0.3% and 4.6%, respectively.

Consumption of natural gas backs down in April (-15.9% vs. Apr. 2013), conventional consumption decreases (-19.0%) and, also, LNG direct consumption (-20.3%). By contrast, consumption aimed at power generation rebounded in April, vs 11.8% in April 2013 when the record low was recorded.
