


In February road fuel consumption dropped (-2.2% with respect to 2016)

## **Preliminary Consumption** Information February 2017

In February, road fuel consumption decreased (-2.2% vs. February 2016). This drop is principally justified by 2016 been a leap year - both gasolines (-4.1%) and road diesels (-1.8%) declined. In the year-to-date consumption, road diesel grew a 1.2% whilst gasolines consumption lowered a 1.0%.

This month, kerosene (+8.4%) and LPG's (+4.6%) consumption increased whilst gasoil (-4,1%), gasolines (-4.0%) and fuel oil (-7.3%) decreased. In the year-todate, LPG's (+16.8%), kerosenes (+11.5%) and gasoil (+1.4%) presented positive variation rates. However, gasolines and fuel oil consumption showed negative rates, -1,0% and -9.4% respectively.

For the seventh consecutive month, natural gas consumption augmented (+0.4% vs. February 2016). Power generation consumption continued showing remarkable increments (+11.9%) as well as direct consumption LNG (+8.3%). However, conventional consumption decreased 1.3%. Year-to-date consumption rose 13.3% in every natural gas type of supply: conventional (+10.7%), power generation (+29.6%) and direct consumption LNG (+14.9%).
