



Preliminary Consumption Information June 2016

New increase in road fuels consumption (+3.6% compared to June 2015), with similar increases in road diesel (+3.5%) and gasoline (+3.7%). In the YTD consumption of both fuels also raised: 3.9% road diesel and, to a lesser extent, gasoline (+2.5%).


For the second consecutive month, consumption of all product groups increases: LPG (+1.6%), gasoline (+3.7%), gasoil (+3.3%), fuel oil (+4.9%) and kerosene (+8.9%), recording the second highest growth of the year. In the YTD all product groups grow except LPG (-3.5%): gasoline (+2.5%), kerosene (+5.5%), gasoil (+1.8%) and fuel oil (+5.2%).

June shows a slight decrease in consumption of natural gas (-0.7% vs. June 2015). Decrease of all consumption types: conventional (-0.3%), power generation (-1.4%) and mainly LNG direct consumption (-5.2%). In 2016 year-on-year, consumption fell by 1.1% due to lower electricity generation (-15.0%), however, conventional and LNG direct consumption increased 1.6% and 4.0%, respectively.
