

Preliminary Consumption Information

May 2017

Road fuel consumption in May 2017 (2,404 kt) overtakes the levels of May 2011 (2,335 kt)

May registered the best records in a month of May in road fuel consumption since 2010, having increased 5.8% in comparison with the same month in 2016; gasoil (+6.2%) as well as gasolines (+4.1%) rose.

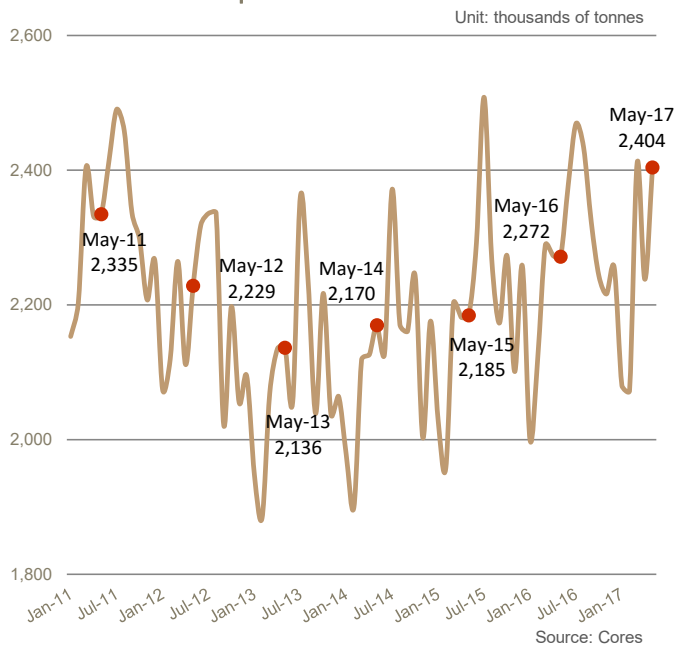
In the year-to-date the consumption of both fuels also augmented: 2.4% for road diesel and, to a lesser extent, road gasolines (+1.8%).

For the first time in the year, every petroleum product consumption grew: LPG (+15.0%), gasolines (+4.1%), kerosene (+7.1%), having reached 557 kt (best register in a month of May), gasoil (+5.0%) and fuel oil (+2.8%).

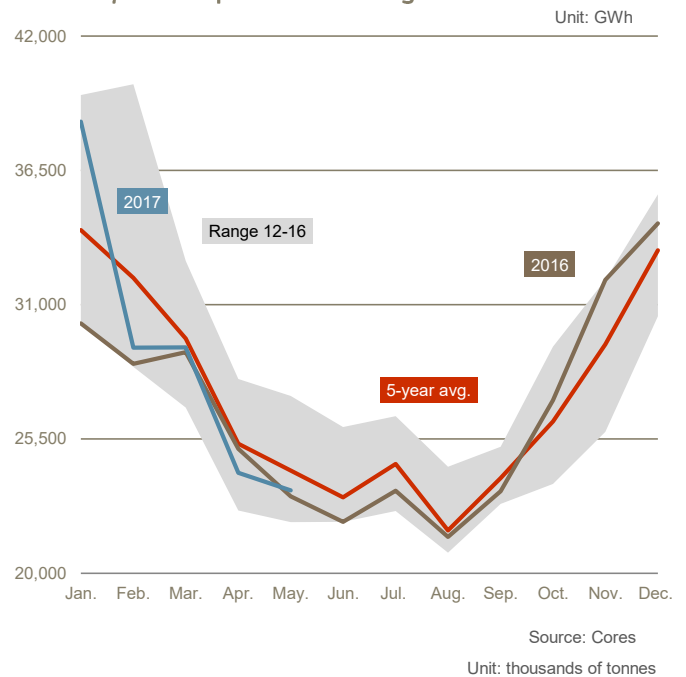
In the year-to-date every petroleum product group presented interannual growth, excepting the fuel oil (-7.7%): LPG (+6.5%), gasolines (+1.8%), kerosene (+10.9%) and gasoil (+0.9%).

Natural gas consumption, after the previous month decrease, rose again in May (+1.1% vs. May 2016), having placed itself in 23,396 GWh. This month increased the one intended for electricity generation (+2.4%) as well as direct consumption LNG (+21.5%), whilst conventional consumption slightly lessened (-0.1%). In the year-to-date, natural gas consumption augmented (+6.2%) due to the increments in every consumption type: conventional (+5.0%), electricity generation (+12.1%) and direct consumption LNG (+14.0%).
